Safe Water in Schools

ITT is committed to bringing safe water, sanitation and hygiene education to 300 schools in water-stressed regions of the developing world – a pledge that will ultimately improve the lives of more than 100,000 children and their families. This is a three-year, \$3 million commitment.

ITT is partnering with Water For People, a leading non-profit organization, to begin this work in schools in West Bengal, India; Quiché, Guatemala and Yoro, Honduras. ITT's support will build new infrastructure to bring water and sanitation to remote rural areas, update existing systems in need of repair and assist in developing innovative hygiene education techniques.

Safe Water in the Face of Disaster

ITT is committed to securing safe water supplies for people in times of emergency. As part of ITT Watermark, ITT has set up an internal Emergency Response Committee and created a process to trigger the effective deployment of financial, product and human resources directly to emergency sites.
